GENERAL INFORMATION AND EVENT RULES

ENTRY FEES

(Each first entry includes 50 cents A.K.C. Recording Fee plus \$3.00 event service fee)

PLEASE NOTE: Each Trial is a separate event and do not count towards 2nd entry for same dog for next trials entry. Per Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter II, Section 2, recording fees are \$.50 per first entry of each dog and Event Service Fees are \$3.00 per entry (not per dog).

FIRST ENTRY OF ALL REGULAR RALLY CLASSES.....\$22.00

ADDITIONAL ENTRY OF THE SAME DOG, SAME TRIAL.....\$15.00

Per Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 5, recording fees are \$3.00 per entry (not per dog)

The highest entry fee is to be considered to be the first entry for each dog per trial.

CLASSES OFFERED:

REGULAR RALLY CLASSES: Rally Novice A/B - Rally Advanced A/B - Rally Excellent A/B, Rally Advanced/Excellent Class (RAE)

NOTE: Rottweiler entries will be counted first with all-breed following. Entries will close when the numerical limit or limits have been reached even if closing date has not been reached. No entry(s) shall be added after the closing time and date specified in the premium list.

NOTE: Entries sent overnight or by any carrier which will require signature upon its' delivery will be declined unless waivers are signed off (you must request mail to be delivered without requirement for signature).

IMPORTANT NOTE: Entries in one or more specified classes will automatically close when certain limits have been reached, even if this occurs before the official closing date.

MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES TO THE SHOW SECRETARY: Kathy Kochendorfer, PO Box 2484, Palmer, AK, 99645, (907)982-1503. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Policy re: NSF Checks for RCA Entries: Offender must make good on NSF check and pay all outstanding fees and charges incurred by Club resulting from NSF Check. Additional restrictions may result on future entries for the offender.

ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Event Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly.

If because of riots, civil disturbances, weather or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.

IF A DOG IS ENTERED in more than one class, the highest priced class shall be considered the first entry. The show giving club may decline any entries for cause or indebtedness to the club over thirty days past due. The club may refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show premises due to disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof for such action.

NO ENTRY shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance, this includes post dated checks or requesting checks to be held until a certain date.

To be acceptable an entry must be submitted with the required entry fee on an official AKC entry form. DOGS entered in a wrong class may not be transferred to another class. HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING SURE THEIR DOGS ARE ENTERED IN THE CORRECT CLASS. Any change request must be received in writing prior to the closing date and time. Email is acceptable: okcorral@mtaonline.net

RCA will refund 50% of entry fee to entrants whose bitch comes in season after entries have closed. Refund may be obtained by sending a written statement to trial secretary. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification a minimum of 30 minutes prior to start of judging. Email is acceptable.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING DOGS

Select the classes for which your dog is eligible, then fill out the entry completely. Please TYPE or PRINT clearly. The Club assumes no liability for wrong information.

Please help us make sure your entries are correct which may include OFA and CERF numbers and which will be listed in the show catalog. The complete numbers should be written on the entry form following the name of the dog. If not using the attached entry form, please make sure you are using the most current one available on AKC through downloading.

EVENT RULES

ALL DOGS shall be held on leash except when in the Obedience Ring. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. The use of corrective devices is strictly prohibited on the show grounds. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities or building parking regulations.

EXHIBITORS and HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and for cleaning up after their dogs.

DOGS SHOULD BE PRESENT in ample time before their scheduled judging time and they may be removed as soon as they are no longer needed for competition. Once brought into the grounds, a dog entered in this show may not be withheld from competition unless excused by a Judge, Veterinarian or the Event Committee.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT for any dog holding up a class. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance to the judging ring when the class is scheduled to be judged. Owners or handlers of the dog are solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or handler when the dog's presence is needed in the show ring. Only dogs entered at this show are allowed on show grounds.

THE MANAGEMENT will exercise every precaution for the safety of the dogs exhibited and it is understood that neither the club nor the management nor the landlord will be responsible for the loss of damage to, or any other damage caused by any dog for any cause.

THE EVENT COMMITTEE will use due diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in the show.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is the responsibility of the exhibitor, who must exercise control and restraint over the child while the child is on the show premises. Failure to do so will result in action by the Event Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Rottweiler Club of Alaska does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

AN EXERCISE AREA will be provided. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to take care of their dogs and to clean any area soiled by their dogs.
